BIOGRAPHY

Tony Succar is a GRAMMY® and three-time Latin GRAMMY®-winning producer, composer, and percussionist, renowned for his innovative fusion of salsa, jazz, and Afro-Latin rhythms. Born in Lima and raised in Miami, he rose to global fame with Unity: The Latin Tribute to Michael Jackson.

His mother, Mimy Succar, a Peruvian-Japanese vocalist, launched her international career in the 1960s. In 2025, she won two GRAMMY® Awards, including Best Tropical Latin Album for Alma, Corazón y Salsa, a live recording with Tony. This live album made them the first Peruvian artists to win a GRAMMY® in that category.

The youngest member of the family, Kenyi Succar, contributed as co-producer, songwriter of the hit "AEO," and live performer (keyboards and DJ).
