### **ABOUT**

He has won 6 Latin Grammy Awards, 5 Lunas del Auditorio Nacional Awards in Mexico, 5 Amigo Awards, 3 Premios de la Música, and 2 Ondas Awards, as well as a Grammy nomination for his album "Indestructible" and another for Best Tropical Solo Artist at the Billboard Awards.

He has sold more than two million albums, achieving several gold records in different countries such as Spain, Mexico, Colombia, Argentina, and Venezuela. Winner of the BBC's "Crossing Borders" award for his work with world music, his tours have taken him to more than 30 countries across five continents and to some of the most prestigious stages, such as Carnegie Hall in New York, Disney Hall and the Hollywood Bowl in Los Angeles, the State Theatre in Sydney, the Auditorio Nacional in Mexico City, the Monte Carlo Opera, the Olympia in Paris, the Barbican in London, and the Bunkamura Orchard Hall in Tokyo.

He has collaborated with artists such as Bebo Valdés, Alicia Keys, Alejandro Fernández, Ricky Martin, Lila Downs, Chavela Vargas, Mercedes Sosa, Salif Keita, Mina, Caetano Veloso, Toquinho, and Rosario, among many others.


